

### YOUR VISIT TO WEST GREEN

### **Opening Hours**

From March 6 to 29 December 2024: Wednesday to Sunday 11am to 4.30pm. We are open on Bank Holidays 11am - 4:30pm. The garden opens for Christmas and the Illuminated Garden Adventure from 23 November to 29 December.

There is on site **parking** close to the garden entrance. Parking is charged at £4 during the garden season. There are a number of disabled spaces available on a first come first served basis. Parking is for garden visitors only.

Admission to the gardens is £10 for adults and £5 for children aged 4 to 14 years. Children aged 3 years and under are free. Entry to the garden is free for National Trust members during 2024. Dogs are not permitted in the garden.

The **Tea Room**, located in the gardens, is open from 11am to 4pm, serving morning tea and coffee, freshly prepared lunches, cakes, biscuits and ice cream. A full traditional Afternoon Tea served in our flower-filled Greenhouse including a garden visit at £30pp. Please call the garden office to book.

**Toilets** and a baby changing facility are located in the Alice Garden.

**Picnics** are permitted in the apple orchard adjacent to the car park to garden visitors only. Picnics are not permitted in the garden.

All **Special Events** at West Green are devised and managed by the in-house team at West Green. These events have no connection with the National Trust and are therefore not covered by the free entry policy for National Trust members. West Green House was purchased two decades ago from the National Trust on a long lease. Today it is privately funded and maintained. It is not administered by the National Trust.




